



## Installing Journeywerks Advanced

This download is a fully functional 45-day trial of **Journeywerks Advanced**. To open Journeywerks, you'll need to install FileMaker. The easiest way is to visit [journeywerks.com](http://journeywerks.com) and go to the Downloads page for a direct link, though you can also search online for FileMaker. During the trial, FileMaker can only be installed on one computer. If you purchase FileMaker you can install on your network. Journeywerks works either way, but you must install FileMaker to use Journeywerks.

To get started, simply unzip the Journeywerks file. Once FileMaker is installed, double-click the file named Journeywerks to launch it. Be sure to keep all the files within the Journeywerks folder intact, as they're essential for the program to function properly. After Journeywerks opens you will need to log in. The default user is **100**, and the password is **admin**. While certain features, like the timeclock, do not require you to log in all Admin features, including creating work orders, will require you to log in. You can create new employees and set privileges for each employee to access differing features. See [How To Get Started Using Journeywerks](#) for more information.

When you're ready to purchase, you can continue using the copy already on your desktop. Alternatively, for multi-user access across your business, install FileMaker Server on your network and place your copy of Journeywerks on the server. Your team can then access Journeywerks from any computer on the network or from iPads and iPhones using the free FileMaker Go app. The transition is seamless, and any records you've already created will remain intact.

If you'd prefer to explore Journeywerks before diving into full use, feel free to experiment on the desktop version. You can create as many records as you'd like, learn the ropes, and then transition to a fresh copy on your network once you're comfortable. We actually encourage this method—try out a few test jobs to see how Journeywerks works before committing your company's data.
